You can either drop your gift off at SHFD by December 12th or Drop it off at the school office by December 11th.

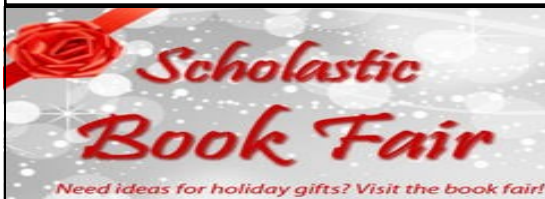


Attendance Awareness
