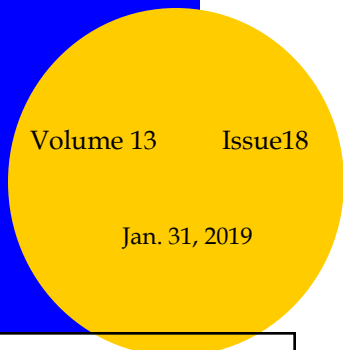

The 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Sweet Home Charter School Read-A-Thon began this past Tuesday. This is Reading Ninja Warrior-themed “fun”raiser aimed at generating greater school spirit while also encouraging children to develop a greater love for reading.

**How it works:**

- ✓ Your child will read or be read to for a 20 minute session
- ✓ Reflect through one written entry on the Reading Response Log at the end of each 20 minute reading session
- ✓ Complete & return the Reading Response log to the child’s classroom teacher
  - All parts of the log must be filled out for students to receive credit.
  - Parent/guardian must sign the log to verify that the child read for the allotted time.
- ✓ Obtain a new Reading Response Log, continue reading, & increase chances to win- Aspire to Greatness!

***Prizes Include:***

- SHCS Top Reader (most minutes read overall)- 1 month free classes at Master Patton’s UWTA Taekwondo
- Top Reader (per grade)- \$5 certificate Scholastic Book order
- All children who read 750 minutes will be entered into a drawing for a 4-in-1 Quikset Game Table.
